The service is open to all women,

regardless of their religious affiliation, political opinion and moral values.

Services provided

- Psychosocial consultations
- Legal information: family law, divorce, domestic violence...
- Help with administrative procedures: guaranteed minimum income, legal assistance...
- Support from other professionals: lawyer, court, police...
- Admission interview in a women's shelter
- Conferences, training in domestic violence
- Seminars, support groups

All psychosocial counsellors have undergone training in prevention and intervention in cases of domestic violence.

Several counsellors are trained in psychotraumatology.

Target population:

Any woman questioning her marriage/life with her partner

Any woman experiencing different forms of violence at the hands of her partner:

- Psychological violence: insults, threats...
- Economic violence: control, financial deprivation...
- Physical violence: blows, beatings...
- Sexual violence: touching, forced sex acts...

Any woman can:

- Develop a safety plan
- Find a way out of her situation
- Overcome her experience of violence
- Strengthen her own resources
